As a Slitting Operator in our TTR Finishing Department, you will be responsible for operating a slitting work center to produce to scheduled demand. You will be performing job and material changes on slitting machines, performing quality control inspections, trouble-shooting equipment problems, communicating equipment, material, or quality issues to team coordinators and technical support staff for assistance, entering production, downtime and inventory data and maintaining a safe, clean and organized work area. This position requires the ability and willingness to stand in one location for a 12 hour shift, and requires frequent bending, lifting, hand-eye dexterity and the physical moving of product and storage containers up to 50 pounds, which are used in the production process.

This is a night shift position, working a 2-2-3, 11.75 hour shift schedule. Qualifications and job requirements include:
